Small Groups

All small groups will be grade/gender/campus-based, and will be led by one of our small group leaders. Our hope is to have no more than eight students per small group.

Small Group Leaders

All small group leaders will submit a background check (if not already on file). Small group leaders are usually the same leaders that your student sees each weekend.

Transportation

Other than drop-off and pick-up by parents/guardians, no transportation is necessary.

Frequently Asked Questions

What will supervision look like?

Students will be supervised at all times by small group leaders, parents staying overnight, and Summit staff. Every adult serving will receive a background check.

Where will my student sleep?

Students will stay in gender-specific rooms with their small group or students from their campus. Students should bring a sleeping bag or mat to sleep on.

What if my student wants to take pictures?

We recognize that many students do not have cameras and use their phones to take pictures. If your child would like to take pictures, please either give them a camera or ask their group leader to take pictures to give them at the end of the weekend.
